



HABC - Level 2 Award in COSHH including Risk Assessments

Introduction

The Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations 2002 (COSHH) requires employers to control exposure to hazardous substances to prevent ill-health. The Level 2 Certificate in COSHH Risk Assessment provides formal recognition of an individual's ability to undertake a COSHH risk assessment in line with the Health and Safety Executive's Approved Code of Practice.

Learning Outcomes – The learner will

- 1. Understand the law relating to hazardous substances in the workplace
- 2. Understand how risk assessments contribute to the safe use of hazardous substances in the workplace
- Understand the precautions and procedures necessary to ensure the risks associated with hazardous substances are properly controlled

- Outline the control hierarchy in respect of safe use, handling, transporting, storage and disposal of substances hazardous to health
- Outline the types of information that should be referred to for the safe identification and use of hazardous substances
- Describe the general procedures that should be in place for dealing with an incident involving hazardous substances

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
