Course Description

The NEBOSH International General Certificate in Occupational Safety and Health is designed for anyone (managers, supervisors and workers) in any type of organisation. The GIC2 unit aims to develop your knowledge and understanding further in all aspects of hazard management and control and assist you in identifying signs of developing hazards in the workplace.

All NEBOSH Certificates are accepted by the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health as meeting the academic requirements for Technician membership of IOSH (Tech IOSH) and is accredited to Level 3 within the National Qualification Framework.

The International Institute of Risk and Safety Management (IIRSM) also accept NEBOSH Certificates as meeting the requirements for associate membership.
