The NGC1 Unit is the core module of several NEBOSH Certificates as it provides essential training in areas such as risk assessment and health and safety auditing practices. The NGC1 unit has been designed to not only give you a well-rounded knowledge of health and safety, but to also provide a foundation platform for continuing into more NEBOSH units and specialised training areas. NGC1 unit provides essential elements that cover health and safety in the workplace.

In addition to the NGC1 unit, each NEBOSH Certificate contains its own set of approved learning books that will develop knowledge for health and safety management. NEBOSH Certificates are nationally recognised qualifications that will assist you and your organisation by lowering the risk of hazards and hazard management.

All NEBOSH Certificates are accepted by the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health as meeting the academic requirements for Technician membership of IOSH (Tech IOSH) and is accredited to Level 3 within the National Qualification Framework.

The International Institute of Risk and Safety Management (IIRSM) also accept NEBOSH Certificates as meeting the requirements for associate membership.
